### **SOMERSET COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT**

Mr. McCarty stated annual food inspections are up-to-date and a recreational bathing facility inspection was performed for the Somerset Lake and Game Club which has resulted in a passing status as a result of satisfactory lab results. In addition, he added that the Somerset County Health Department continues to staff COVID19 vaccination clinics.

Mr. Rinzler requested confirmation on the policy regarding facial covering requirements for staff with facial hair in local food establishments. Mr. McCarty stated regulations are in place per the New Jersey Sanitary Food Code (N.J.A.C.E. 8-24) indicating hair restraints must be worn by an individual prepping food.

On behalf of the Borough of Far Hills, Mayor Vallone thanked the Somerset County Health Department on their constant efforts to ensure the residents of the Borough of Far Hills remain informed with up-to-date information regarding any potential health issues. In addition, Councilwoman Tweedie and Mr. Rinzler commended the Somerset County Health Department on the success of the ongoing COVID19 vaccination sites. General discussion ensued regarding COVID19.

Mayor Vallone stated he had spoken with the Atlantic Health Visiting Nurse Association regarding their fall Rummage Sale which they anticipate will take place in 2021.
