

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance prohibits and establishes regulations on illicit connections to the Municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Borough of Far Hills in compliance with NJDEP requirements.

**BOROUGH OF FAR HILLS
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-25**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ILLICIT CONNECTIONS
TO THE MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM
OPERATED BY THE BOROUGH OF FAR HILLS.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Far Hills, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The following requirements and regulations shall be established in the Borough of Far Hills:

**ILLICIT CONNECTIONS TO THE MUNICIPAL
SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM**

Article I Purpose.

An Ordinance prohibiting illicit connections to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the Borough of Far Hills, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

Article II Definitions.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this Ordinance clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word “shall” is always mandatory and not merely directory. The definitions below are the same as or based on corresponding definitions in the New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) rules at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.2.

a. Domestic sewage - waste and wastewater from humans or household operations.

b. Illicit connection – any physical or non-physical connection that discharges domestic sewage, non-contact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater) to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Borough of Far Hills, unless that discharge is authorized under a NJPDES permit other than the Tier A Municipal Stormwater General Permit (NJPDES Permit Number NJ0141852). Non-physical connections may include, but are not limited to, leaks, flows, or overflows into the municipal separate storm sewer system.

c. Industrial waste - non-domestic waste, including, but not limited to, those pollutants regulated under Section 307(a), (b), or (c) of the Federal Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. §1317(a), (b), or (c)).

d. Municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4)– a conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, manmade channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by the Borough of Far Hills or other public body, and is designed and used for collecting and conveying stormwater.

e. NJPDES permit – a permit issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to implement the New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) rules at N.J.A.C. 7:14A

f. Non-contact cooling water - water used to reduce temperature for the purpose of cooling. Such waters do not come into direct contact with any raw material, intermediate product (other than heat) or finished product. Non-contact cooling water may however contain algaecides, or biocides to control fouling of equipment such as heat exchangers, and/or corrosion inhibitors.

g. Person – any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.

h. Process wastewater - any water which, during manufacturing or processing, comes into direct contact with or results from the production or use of any raw material, intermediate product, finished product, byproduct, or waste product. Process wastewater includes, but is not limited to, leachate and cooling water other than non-contact cooling water.

i. Stormwater – water resulting from precipitation (including rain and snow) that runs off the land’s surface, is transmitted to the subsurface, is captured by separate storm sewers or other sewerage or drainage facilities, or is conveyed by snow removal equipment.

Article III Prohibited Conduct.

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged through an illicit connection to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Borough of Far Hills any domestic sewage, non-contact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater).

Article IV Enforcement.

This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Police Department, Zoning Officer, and/or Construction Code Enforcement Official or designated representative of the Borough of Far Hills.

Article V Violations and Penalties.

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to the general penalty provisions of the Borough of Far Hills.

Section 2. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough of Far Hills, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern, and the inconsistencies of the prior ordinance are hereby repealed. All other parts, portions and provisions of the Ordinances of the Borough of Far Hills are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.


Section 4. Within five (5) days after its adoption by the Council, this Ordinance shall be presented to the Mayor for his approval and signature, which approval shall be granted or denied within ten (10) days of receipt of same, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:60-5(d). If the Mayor fails to return this Ordinance with either his approval or objection to same within ten (10) days after it has been presented to him, then this Ordinance shall be deemed approved.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon (1) adoption; (2) approval by the Mayor pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:60-5(d); and (3) publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
